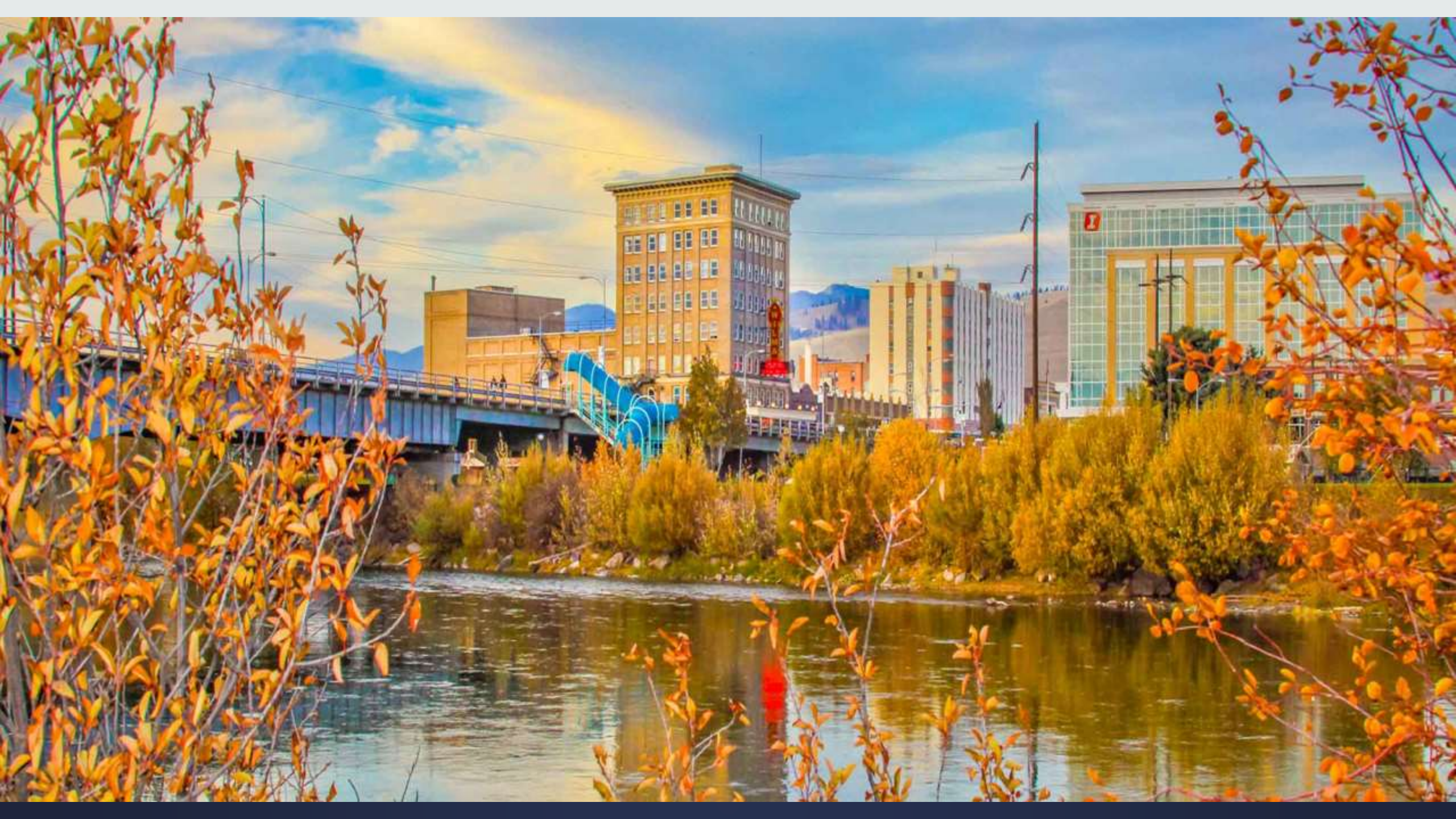

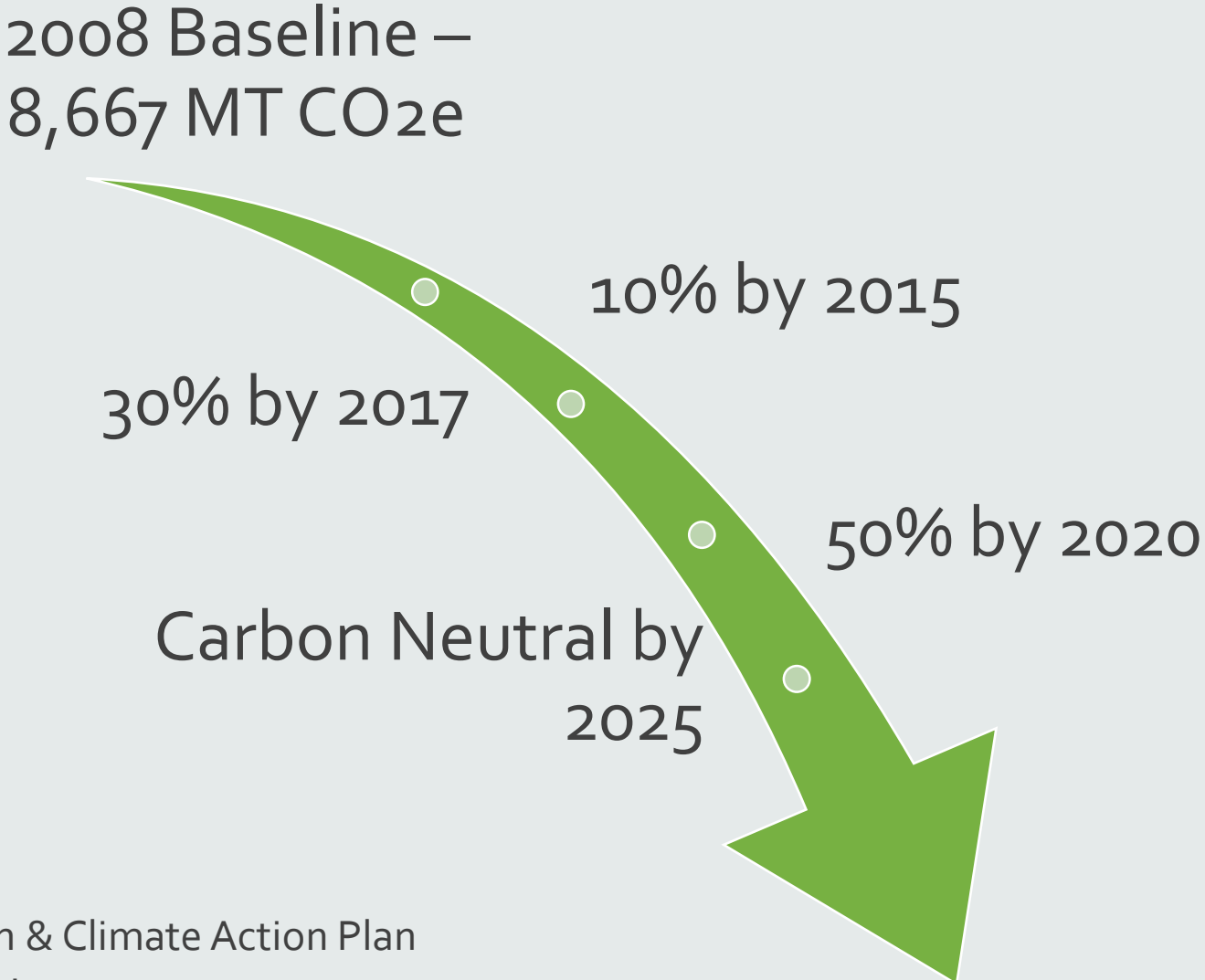
- 1996 – U.S. Conference of Mayors' Climate Protection Agreement Signed

- 2014 – First Carbon Emissions Inventory Update



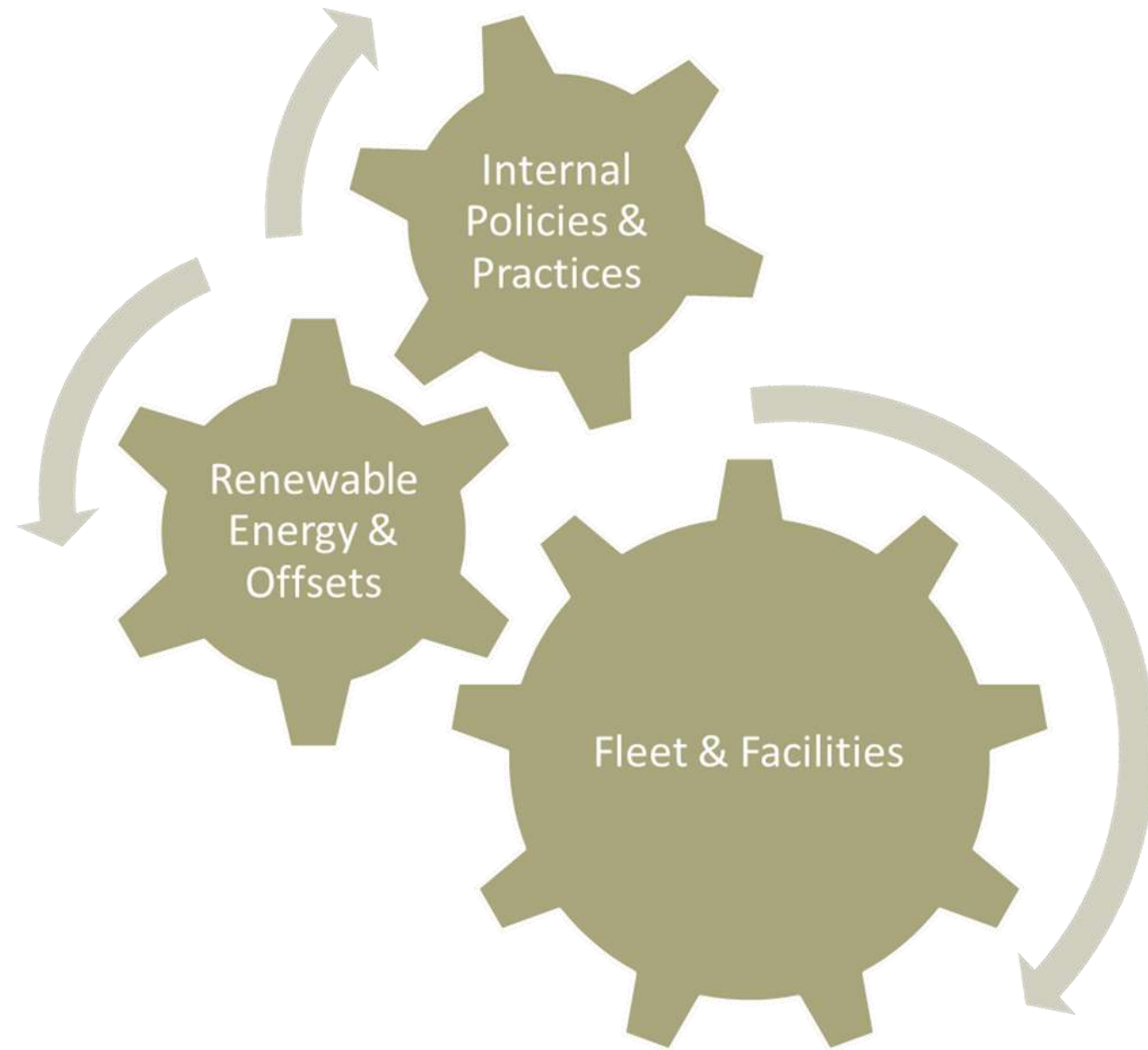

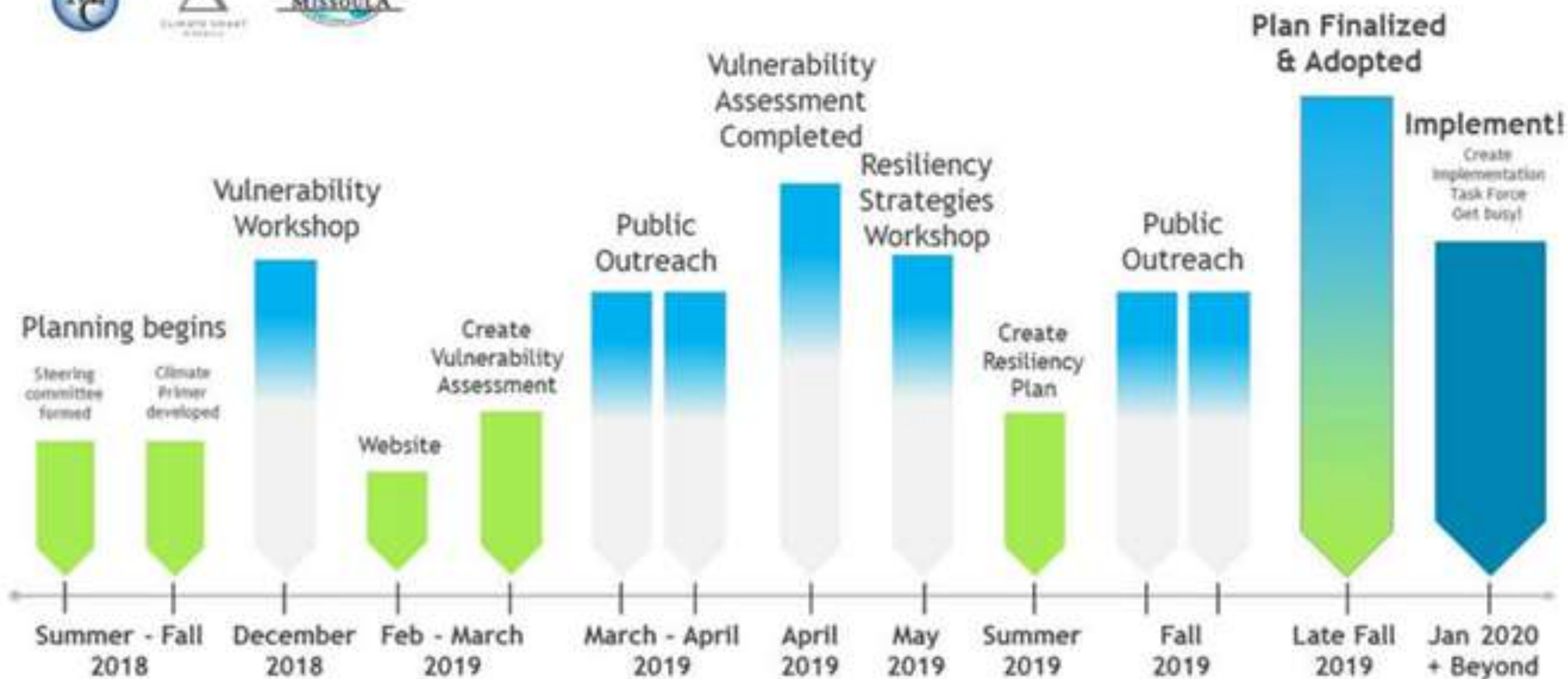

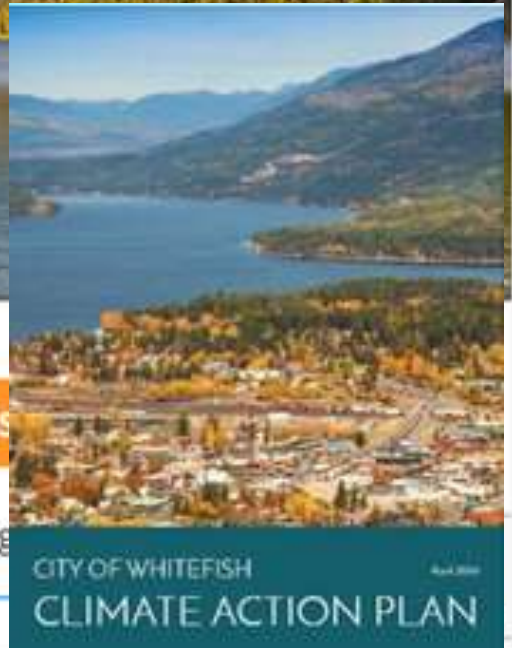
Whitefish Climate Action Plan
